This Sunday, our Chancel Choir and friends will present a joyous Christmas Cantata at both the 8:30 and 11:00 services. The Christmas Cantata, in its contemporary form, dates back to the early 17th century. The cantata combines choir, soloists, instruments and spoken dialogue to narrate the story of Christ's birth. It is a powerful medium for expressing the hope, peace, joy, and love surrounding the birth of Christ. Our Christmas Chancel Choir is excited to bring Pepper Choplin's *The Seven Noels* to our Wynnton Sanctuary. The centerpiece of this Cantata is a favorite Christmas hymn, *The First Noel*. Stylistically, the music ranges from prayerful ballads to joyful, rhythmic celebrations. One of the movements, *Never Been a Night*, has been described as a gospel Christmas party! The first six Noels are short musical narrations for soloists and ensembles that propel the story forward. The seventh Noel is a beautiful, lyrical song of praise which includes an opportunity for the congregation to sing a verse of the hymn *The First Noel*. This Sunday, we invite you to experience familiar carols and hymns and beautiful new melodies that blend together to illustrate the wonder and joy of the Christmas story. As we receive this joy, let us praise God and share the *Good News!*



READING THROUGH THE BIBLE

Joseph: December 10-16 Matthew 1:1-25



This week we will be reading about Joseph. Too often we overlook the importance of Joseph in the Christmas story, but he played an important role in the childhood of Jesus. Betrothal is different than the engagement we would think of; if he wanted to break his engagement, then it would be much closer to a divorce.
