SUMMER CAMP MEETING AT WYNNTON!



July 9, 2023

This Sunday, we begin our Camp Meeting Sundays through Labor Day. Camp Meeting revivals created a tradition of music and hymn singing with strong lyrics and lilting, rhythmic melodies. Historically, the music was preceded by folk music and succeeded by gospel hymns. Hymns were taught and learned by rote. Words and music were created and developed in folk music style. The hymns that emerged from the revivals influenced the music for social worship. Revival songs developed to evangelize and strengthen social worship. The music of Camp Meeting revivals fostered simple refrain songs/hymns with multiple verses and a repeated refrain or chorus. *Marching to Zion, Love Lifted Me, Shall We Gather at the River, Precious Name, Redeemed, At Calvary, What a Friend We Have In Jesus,* and *To God Be the Glory,* represent a small example of the beloved hymns that were born out of Camp Meeting revivals.

Camp Meetings were originally held in frontier areas where people without regular preachers would travel to a site to pray, sing hymns, and listen to itinerant preachers. These revival meetings emerged from a protestant religious revival in the United States known as The Second Great Awakening. This movement, from about 1795 to 1835, made conversion, or soul-winning, the focus of ministry. During the Second Great Awakening, theology in many denominations shifted as preachers emphasized the ability of sinners to make an immediate decision for their own salvation. This wave of evangelism also led to the founding of several colleges and seminaries, and to the organization of mission communities across the country.

Sunday, we will join together to "sing the old familiar songs," and to pray and hear the Word together. We celebrate our redemption as our choirs call us to worship with a choir and congregation favorite; "Great Gettin' Up Mornin'." We will sing endearing anthems overflowing with joy as we share "I'll Fly Away" at the 8:30 service and "Jesus Is the Friend Who's Always There" at the 11:00 service. SEE YOU AT CAMP!


