"Words to Live By"

As we step into this week, we begin a journey that allows us to walk together in surrender and humility to the cross. I know that many people in this world have not forgotten the endpoint of the journey, but they totally neglect the importance of the journey that led to Golgotha. So many thoughts go through my head each year as we step into the life, death, and resurrection of Christ. I cannot fully fathom the difficulty of the many decisions He made in order that we could receive such an amazing gift of grace.

We have been walking through the Sermon on the Mount and listening as Jesus has been pleading with our hearts to AWAKEN to the fullness of Christ's message to His church. Every time I read the words from Matthew 5-7, I am reminded that this was truly the beginning of His message to us as it pertains to His decision to encounter the cross. He was trying to help us see through His eyes and understand the fullness of God's love, but we still wanted something more. We could see the simplicity of the Gospel as it stood before us, and even today, we still question the fullness of His authority over our lives.

This week I learned that more that 6.6 million people drive by our church in a given year. Let's let that sink in for a second... 6.6 Million people drive by our campus in a given year. This Lenten season, I am inviting you to walk with me through some of the most powerful words that Jesus spoke to us on His journey to the cross--words and phrases that have so much power, yet many times we have failed to take the time to hear them and apply them in our lives. Over the next seven weeks, we will take a journey into God's Word and recognize that Jesus has given us everything we need to live a life filled with compassion... desire. . .vision...and faith. Words that challenge us to endure the times of discouragement...thirst...surrender...and trust.

I challenge us all in the next 46 days to stretch ourselves once again to listen to the Words of God as He is preparing us once again to speak into the future direction for Wynnton. God has been and will continue to stir our hearts and minds as we walk through this year with a new attitude to be stretched like never before. We are in need of these Words to Live By so that we can continue to focus our eyes on the movement of Christ within our church in preparation to extend God's Word to the World. May we receive these ashes as reminders of our journey to humble ourselves and spend the time in remembrance of the Word who came in flesh to teach us how to live.


READING THROUGH THE BIBLE
