If you could wish for one thing, what would it be? Most of the time when we ask this question, if we're being honest, our mind goes to fortune or fame. For a man named Solomon, the answer was wisdom. Solomon was the son of a king. Actually, he was a son of King David, the chosen king of the Lord. That's a lot to live up to. So, when Solomon became king and God asked what He wanted, Solomon asked for wisdom. He wanted to know how to govern God's people better. It was a noble request. It wasn't focused on his wants or desires, but instead it focused on what it was that God had called on him to do.

As we continue our Characters with God's Character sermon series this week, Solomon shows us a new character of God: Wisdom. While Solomon was obedient and humble before the Lord, he also showed good judgement in understanding that he wasn't enough on his own. Solomon wanted to do the best job that he could serving God in the position he was blessed with. But he didn't have years of experience in ruling, because he wasn't the firstborn trained to be king. Solomon didn't have that experience. Solomon needed God.

I asked earlier what you would wish for because there was more to Solomon's request than wisdom. Solomon asked for God's help, because he so desperately needed God to see the job through. What would you wish for? How about wishing for God to help us serve him better. That's what Solomon did, and that was the wisest thing he ever did.

Noah, Solomon, and so many other important people from the Old Testament knew that the best thing they could do was to lean into God. That doesn't mean they're perfect, but it means they had the character to serve, and ask God to take care of the rest.

WYNNTON NEIGHBORHOOD NETWORK

During the months of April, May and June we served 1,621 families containing 4,912 individuals, including 2,147 children. This is the second busiest quarter on record. Last summer was busier, but since then we have limited ourselves to 25 clients per day. We are still forced to purchase much of our food retail, which means our cost per family has increased greatly. The line of people waiting for food seems to start earlier and earlier. Today, there were more than 25 families waiting in line by 9:30 a.m. even though we don't open until 10a.m., and many families had to be told to return tomorrow. Most days are like this. Likewise, our utilities volunteers are very busy, more so now that summer electric bills are starting to arrive. During the last three months, we assisted 162 families with their utility bills and spent \$15,176,83.

Now more than ever we need your prayers. We are so grateful for the amazing generosity of all of our member congregations with their time, money and food. Your kindness touches many lives here.

Our dynamic duo, Kay and Donna, will play the festive and lively piano in four-hands accompaniment. Shacklev's choral arrangement provides a rousing, joyful version of this hymn-song. As we sing and listen to this anthem, it is hard not to wonder if both composer and arranger were influenced by the music of the March King, John Philip Sousa. Let me know what you think!


