About fifteen minutes later, my wife Michaela comes in and just looks at me. "What are you doing? It's only forty degrees out, you're being crazy!" Then the power came back on. See, I don't like the cold, and so at the first instance of cold coming in our home I freaked out. But, on the other side of it, I know that there really wasn't anything to be worried about. It wasn't cold enough to really hurt us, and we had plenty of blankets to keep us warm until the power came on.

The storm I worried so much about seemed so much smaller on the other side when you really looked at what was there. The storms in our lives are so often like that. It seems so terrifying, but then once we get through it with a little support, they can seem so small.

The storms we encounter are so rarely as easy to face as a little lost power in forty-degree weather. But, even still we can get through them with the support we have been offered in God.

What do we have to fear with God at our side? When the storms of life hit, remember that God is always ready to shield you from the wind, if only you have a little faith.

JOYFUL NOTES FROM THE CHOIR!
