The Chancel Choir will share a time-tested anthem this Sunday; *Sing and Be Not Silent*, by Mary McDonald. Based on Psalm 30, which was composed by King David during a time of celebration and gratitude, it reminds us to be thankful to God in all things. Though we may experience temporary trials and sorrows, God's favor is everlasting, and joy comes in the morning. The text of this Psalm gives us insight into our human experience; from struggles to blessings. This message still resonates with us today.

Mary McDonalds's *Sing and Be Not Silent* radiates with energy from beginning to end. Contrasting meter and driving rhythms lead us to an elegant legato (slow and smooth) section then returns us to the original message and a triumphant finish.
